WILD OATS IS A ROOTIN-TOOTIN GOOD TIME!

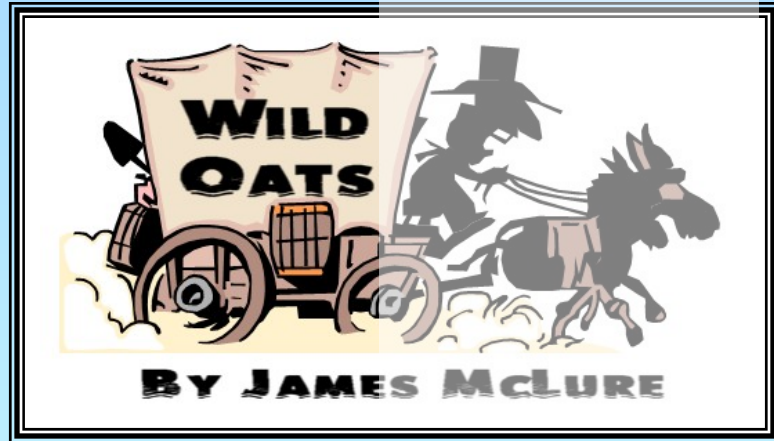

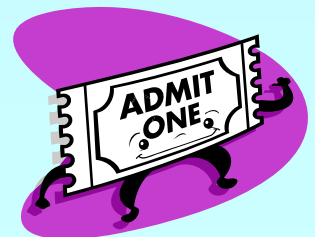

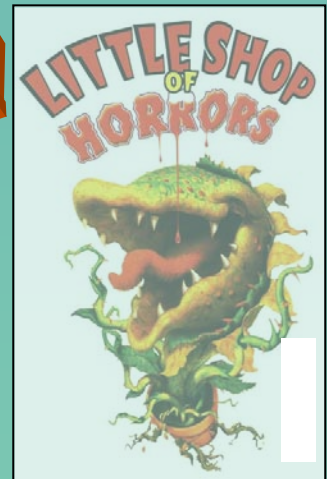
